Cottage Redevelopment Update

In 2018, the process of redevelopment began on the cottage line with the replacement of Beechtree and in 2019 the addition of the new sustainable duplex through a partnership with The Endeavour Centre-a sustainable building school. The duplex meets the following benchmarks:

- minimal environmental impact through the use of all environmentally preferred products
- ultra-low embodied carbon footprint
- low energy use (50-75% less than code)
- fully non-toxic indoor environment quality
- a comprehensive waste management plan to reduce project waste by 50%

This redevelopment is funded 100% through donations from our cottage line; this is a very exciting step in the redevelopment of YMCA Geneva Park. It will allow us to move forward on our commitment to investing in technology that will minimize the environmental impact of our operations. The building itself was designed with input from our Cottage Development Committee and was our first fully-winterized cottage.

YMCA GENEVA PARK "TENURE AND APPLICATION PROCESS"

In an effort to help all YMCA Geneva Park Family Camp Participants better understand how cottages and suites are allocated each summer; please review the following procedures and practices:

"Cottage & Suite Tenure" is the method by which YMCA Geneva Park's management identifies those families renting a Cottage or Suite, who have the first right to a specified rental unit during a specified time period. The process and conditions of Tenure which guide YMCA Geneva Park are as follows:

- 1. Tenure is achieved after a family has occupied the <u>same</u> cottage or suite for <u>5 consecutive</u> years during the same <u>week number</u>. Week number is determined by counting back from the week ending on Saturday before Labour Day <u>as week number 12</u>.
- 2. Every year, families who have earned tenure must apply before the published deadline date (on all application forms) for their cottage or suite for the coming season.
- 3. Families with tenure may be absent from YMCA Geneva Park for one year within a three year period without loss of tenure providing there is written notification. If no application is submitted in the second year, tenure will be forfeited. Extensions to this year of absence may be granted by management based on extenuating circumstances.
- 4. As a family with tenure, you may wish to designate the tenured time to an immediate family member (offspring, grandchildren and siblings). To do so, communication to and confirmation from YMCA Geneva Park is essential. Tenure cannot be designated to community members who are not part of your immediate family.
- 5. If individual situations or circumstances requiring special consideration arise, the decision is left to the discretion of the General Manager of YMCA Geneva Park.

The process and conditions of "Cottage & Suite Allocation" which guide YMCA Geneva Park are as follows:

- 1. To be considered for allocation in a cottage or suite. An application must be submitted no earlier than **November 17, 2019** and no later than the deadline of **November 30, 2019**.
- 2. Tenured guests will be allocated in their tenured cottage/suite first.
- 3. Returning families applying for the same cottage in the same week will be allocated second.
- 4. All remaining cottages and suites will be allocated based on availability. Remember to send in your applications as early as possible as of November 17, 2019; applications will be dated upon receipt (fax/email) or based on postmark (if sent by post).
- 5. Families who are not allocated a cottage or suite will be placed on a waiting list.

In an effort to help us move towards paperless application and increased email communication, please remember to include your correct email address on the application.

Due to the volume of applicants, YMCA Geneva Park staff does NOT send confirmation when we have received your application. For confirmation, please contact Geneva Park directly. Applications can be sent by:
