









YMCA Camp Kitchikewana Overnight Camp Programs

Camp Kitchikewana is a skills based camp with a focus on water-based activities, creative arts, and environmental awareness. Camp Kitchikewana is uniquely located on Beausoleil Island in Georgian Bay Islands National Park.

Waterbug Club (1 week) 6-9 Years Old

\$1,010 • June 28 - July 4 | July 5-11 | Aug 16-22 | Aug 23-29

A perfect introduction for first-time campers focusing on creativity, developing friendships and having fun. Campers will be introduced to traditional programs, land and water activities, games and sing-songs.

Traditional Camp (2 weeks) 7-14 Years Old

\$1,770 • June 28 - July 11 | July 12 - July 25 | Aug 2 - 15 | Aug 16-29

Memories are made each session with a blend of skill instruction, all-camp activities and outdoor pursuits. Special programs top off the two week camp experience, including the Sailing Regattas, the Lumberman and Voyageur Games.

Sailing Camp (2 weeks) 12-14 Years Old

\$1,850 • July 12-25 | Aug 2-15

Campers take part in extensive sailing lessons with a focus on racing and being exposed to different types of sailboats and teaching practices. The highlight of this program is a sail around the south end of Beausoleil Island.

Leadership One (4 weeks) 15 Years Old

\$2,980 • June 28 - July 25 | Aug 2-29

Campers will build self-esteem and experience personal growth, with a focus on skills development, personal leadership and communication. Camper experiences include learning the fundamentals of trip leadership planning (5-day canoe trip) and a focus on advanced skill development (including obtaining a secondary school credit). Application form required.

Leadership Two (4 weeks) 16 Years Old

\$2,980 • June 28 - July 25 | Aug 2-29

Campers will focus on positive community involvement including group dynamics, instructional techniques, counselling skills, camper characteristics and local heritage. Campers will practice their skills and leadership styles under the supervision of experienced camp staff. Opportunity to obtain a secondary school credit available. Application form required.

A \$400 deposit is required with each registration. Fees are + HST.

Camp Kitchikewana & YMCA Geneva Park Refunds & Cancellations:

All deposits are nonrefundable after May 1, 2020. Written cancellations prior to May 1, 2020 are permitted. Applicants will receive a full refund, less an administrative fee of \$200. Cancellations after May 1, 2020 will be granted for medical reasons only. To qualify for a full refund (less an administrative fee) a medical certificate must accompany written notice of cancellation. No refund of any amount will be granted for non-medical cancellations received on or after May 1, 2020. The YMCA of Simcoe/Muskoka reserves the right to cancel registration if the camper's medical information is not completed and if the authorization is not signed by the parent/guardian and returned to the YMCA camping office prior to the commencement of the camp session.

Refunds will not be issued if a participant is removed from the camp program at the request of the participant or parent/guardian or due to behavioural issues. Camp programs may be cancelled due to low registration. If this occurs, those affected by the cancellation will be notified two weeks prior to the program start date and provided with alternate program options if available.

YMCA Geneva Park GP LEAP Programs

GP LEAP Bronze Program (1 week) Age 15 by July 1st

\$770 • Session 1: June 27 - July 4 | Session 2: August 15-22

This program focuses on an Adventure Recreation experience. Participants will learn camp basics on a 'Practice Journey' and then feel the rewards of a 2-day 'Qualifying Journey' canoe trip. This will qualify participants to achieve the Duke of Edinburgh's Adventurous Journey at the Bronze Award Level. The journey ends with reflection and bridging during a solo 'sit-spot' in the wilderness.

GP LEAP Silver Program (2 weeks) Age 16 by July 1st

\$1,330 • Session 1: July 4-18 | Session 2: August 1-15

This program focuses on building hard skills through an Adventure Education lens where participants will begin to think, discuss, and reflect about their experiences. Participants will camp out on a 2-day 'Practice Journey' and then a 4-day 'Qualifying Journey' canoe trip. This fulfills the Duke of Edinburgh's Adventurous Journey requirement at the Silver Award Level. Building knowledge and skills in land, water and challenge-based activity areas will culminate in a reflective 'duet' camp-out experience.

GP LEAP Gold Program (3 weeks) Age 17 by July 1st

\$1,980 • Session 1: June 27 - July 18 | August 1-22

This Adventure Development program focuses on placements in skill areas to develop soft skills and learn the key behaviours of leadership. Leadership skills develop further on a 2-day 'Practice Journey' and then an 8-day 'Qualifying Journey' canoe trip. This satisfies the Duke of Edinburgh's Adventurous Journey requirement at the Gold Award Level. A supervised overnight 'solo' experience will allow actions and reflections to integrate into behavioural leadership change.

GP LEAP Platinum Program (1 or 2 weeks) Age 17+ by July 1st

No Fee • 1 Week Session: August 22-29 | 2 Week Session: July 8 - August 1

This Adventure Development program is a Volunteer opportunity to fully integrate hard and soft skills into action. There will be a variety of positions available. Volunteers will report to the Supervisors and Program Coordinators of the selected program area. Volunteers will live independently on-site and dine with staff.

GP LEAP Expedition 5 Program (1 week) Age 15 or 16 by July 1st \$950 • Session 1: July 18-25



Aquatics Camp 6-8 and 9-12 Years Old

This camp is designed for those looking to improve their swimming skills while participating in a traditional day camp program. Each day, campers will participate in a one hour swimming lesson with a qualified YMCA Swim Instructor and a one hour recreational swim where they can play with friends and practice their new skills.

Horse Camp 9-14 Years Old

Campers will spend their mornings at Foxwood Farm where they will ride well-schooled horses and learn all aspects of horsemanship including proper horse care, grooming and tacking up, and stable management.

New Discoveries 6-8 Years Old

Campers will have the opportunity to develop their love of nature at Springwater Provincial Park! Outdoor activities will include sports and games, hiking, pond study, and survival skills. Each week campers will bus to a local beach for swimming.

Young Naturalists 9-12 Years Old

Campers will develop their outdoor know-how through nature based programming at Springwater Provincial Park. Available activities include shelter building, nature hikes, geocaching, and biking. Each week campers will bus to a local beach for swimming.

Sports Camp 6-8 and 9-12 Years Old

Campers will develop the fundamental skills needed to play a variety of sports including basketball, soccer, volleyball, ultimate frisbee, and more. Emphasis on fun, fitness, fair play, and friends!

Leadership Camp 13-16 Years Old

In this three week program youth will develop their leadership and communication skills through a variety of team building activities. Participants will have the opportunity to plan a camp theme day and assist with younger age groups. Innisfil YMCA

The Innisfil YMCA is a community health, fitness, and aquatics centre featuring a swimming pool, gymnasium, and outdoor field space. The main day camp area is located west of the YMCA building and features a sheltered picnic area and access to the large sports fields. Campers will spend the majority of their day outside and will access the YMCA for swimming and gymnasium use.

Springwater Provincial Park

Springwater is a large provincial park facility featuring hiking trails, a small pond, and shaded pavilions. The main day camp area includes a private shelter with picnic tables and an open field space. Campers will spend their full day outside enjoying the property; pavilions and treed areas will provide shade on hot days.
